### GENERAL

Michael Stover has practiced law for over 28 years. He joined Wright, Constable & Skeen to help lead the Surety & Fidelity law practice at the firm, which has become one of the most well-recognized practices nationally in the surety industry. While Mr. Stover practices predominately in surety and construction law, he is also well experienced in government contracts, professional liability, and general litigation. He is distinguished professionally for his work, earning recognition as a “Super Lawyer®” in surety law from 2015-2019, “The Best Lawyers in America™” for Construction Law from 2013–2019. He also holds the AV Preeminent Peer Review rating from Martindale-Hubbell and the highest rating on AVVO.

In the surety industry, Mr. Stover has represented most of the major surety companies as well as many mid-size and smaller companies. He has been involved as counsel on large multi-state, multi-project contract performance bond defaults, involving workouts, financing and takeovers as well as large national bankruptcy matters for commercial bond sureties. He has also represented sureties in pursuing indemnity, salvage and subrogation rights. Over the years, he has been very active in the surety industry writing articles, giving presentations and attending/sponsoring conferences around the country. In 2010, he spearheaded the creation of the Philadelphia Surety Claims Association and is a founding Officer and member of the Board of Directors. In 2016, he was named a Vice Chair of the ABA/TIPS – Fidelity and Surety Law Committee and continues to serve in that capacity today. He updated Chapter 10, *Payment Bond Surety’s Right to Contract Proceeds*, in the ABA publication titled *The Law of Payment Bonds, 2d Ed.* He co-authored Chapter 4, *Financing the Principal* in the ABA publication titled the *Bond Default Manual, 4th Ed.* and prior to that he co-authored Chapter 20, *The Commercial Surety’s Collateral in a Principal’s Bankruptcy Case* in the ABA publication titled *The Law of Commercial Surety and Miscellaneous Bonds, 2d Ed.*

In May 2016, Mr. Stover spearheaded the creation of the [Surety Today](https://www.suretytoday.net)® live telebriefing/podcast program. Surety Today® is a conference call educational resource for professionals in the surety industry presented monthly by the attorneys of the Surety Law Group at Wright, Constable and Skeen. Surety Today® podcasts offer 30 minutes of in-depth discussion on topics of narrow focus and practical importance to those in the industry. Mr. Stover hosts the program and has presented extensively on numerous surety related topics.
